## The Mirasol Foundation: Celebrating 10 Years of Impact

This year marks the 10th anniversary of the Mirasol Foundation (MFI). Since awarding our very first grants in 2016, our mission has been simple but powerful: to serve neighbors in need right here in Palm Beach County.

We've supported children struggling in school or caught in the foster care system. We've helped families facing homelessness and hunger. We've supported veterans in need of housing, healthcare, and other critical resources. Over the past decade, as the needs in our community have grown, so too has MFI's ability to respond—thanks entirely to you.

Last year alone, your generosity made it possible for us to distribute \$720,835 in grants to 49 carefully vetted charities. Beyond financial gifts, you donated tons (literally!) of food, clothing, diapers, and formula. And more than 250 Mirasol volunteers stepped forward, offering their time and talents to support dozens of organizations. Together, you showed what a compassionate, committed community can do.

As we look back on 10 years of giving, one thing stands out: when the people of Mirasol learn about the needs just beyond our gates, they respond with incredible generosity. Last year, more than 400 households contributed to MFI. If you were among them, thank you. If you haven't yet joined us, we invite you to get involved this year. Our calendar is filled with opportunities—special speakers, raffles, auctions, card parties, our big March Gala, and many volunteer activities (including service hours for teens). There's a way for everyone to take part, have fun and make a difference. The impact is real. Your donations help children sleep in their very own beds for the first time. They provide safety and support for single mothers escaping domestic violence. You change lives.

# THE IMPACT OF OUR GRANTS FROM 2024

In May 2024, we provided 55 charities with grants of \$638,000. We asked each of these charities to prepare six-month and one-year progress reports which described the impact our gift made on the PBC community. Below are a few examples of what was achieved with our grants.

Charity: **27 Sandwiches, Inc.**  
Mission: Provide meals and essential items to the ever-increasing need population in South Florida  
Grant: \$8,000  
Impact: Provided 525 hot meals, plus back packs with t-shirts, hygiene kits, ponchos, blankets, snacks

Charity: **Caridad Center**  
Mission: The largest free clinic in Florida  
Grant: \$20,000  
Impact: Served 5,325 clients with core clinical services and 1,735 clients accessed critical social services (diapers, food, clothes)

Charity: **El Sol**  
Mission: Improve the quality of life by providing services to day-laborers and their families  
Grant: \$10,000  
Impact: Enabled the serving of 22,484 hot meals and to-go lunches providing essential nutrition

Charity: **Faith\*Hope\*Love Charity**  
Mission: Re-integrate displaced and at-risk veterans and their families into the community  
Grant: \$10,000  
Impact: Provided individual psychotherapy sessions to 46 residents struggling with PTSD, homelessness, and health issues

Charity: **Literacy Coalition of PBC**  
Mission: Improve the quality of lives by promoting and achieving literacy  
Grant: \$15,000  
Impact: Funded the literacy program in two elementary schools in Palm Beach Gardens, including ten new books that each child receives during the school year

Charity: **Meals on Wheels of the Palm Beaches, Inc.**  
Mission: Nourish and enrich the lives of homebound seniors by delivery of fresh food daily  
Grant: \$20,000  
Impact: Directly subsidized 3,750 meals (36% of all meals served in the region) plus transportation costs

Charity: **PBC Food Bank**  
Mission: Fighting hunger in PBC by reaching 200,000 individuals each month  
Grant: \$38,000  
Impact: 724 people regularly received nourishing food, plus wholesome recipes for long-term health

Mission: Deliver new beds/bedding to families in need  
Grant: \$15,000  
Impact: Provided 50 PBC residents with beds of their own

Specifically, the funding from this grant subsidized the following:*

- Rent
- Food (supplemented by the campus pantry)
- Transportation
- Medical appointments
- School supplies
- Costs for life skill building activities
- Personal care items/services
- Social activities

*The kind support and services of our community barber and the donations to our food pantry helped to defray some of the costs associated with personal care and groceries.*

*The funding provided by your foundation for this client, and your continued support is greatly appreciated. We were able to provide the resources to ensure that this youth could be supported to realize his goal of graduating high school and to be able to continue his journey of self-sufficiency. The overall effect of your funding has been to assist us in maintaining our housing and client support services for one youth, as we continue to be that bridge that facilitates a path to stability and independence for our youth clientele.*
